- **Provider Award** – for an individual who has exemplified the Family Based Services philosophy in their professional practice.
- **President’s Award** – a discretionary award, used by the NDFBSA Board to identify individuals or programs that excelled in providing family based services over time.
- **Program Award** – for outstanding or innovative family services or for a program that fills a gap in the existing services.
- **Lifetime Membership Award** – for an individual who has provided a minimum of seven years of meritorious service and/or employment in support of Family Based Services philosophy.
- **Special Recognition Award** – Person or program that is innovative and responsive to immediate needs or current issues in keeping with a Family Based Services philosophy.
